

Fall Pumpkin Dip

Ingredients

- 15 oz can of pumpkin
- 5 oz box of instant vanilla pudding (just the powder, do not make the pudding)
- 16 oz container of cool whip {can use low fat}
- small pumpkin
- 1/2 tbsp Pumpkin Pie Spice
- 1/2 tbsp Cinnamon

Directions

- 1. Mix pumpkin, dry pudding mix, cool whip, and pumpkin pie spice together {by hand} in a very large bowl.
- 2. Chill for several hours before serving. Meanwhile, carve your pumpkin!
- 3. Fill pumpkin with mix. Sprinkle with cinnamon, and serve with fresh apples slices, vanilla wafers or ginger snaps.

BOOKBUZZ Bonnie Easton

Here are a few selections for your bookshelf: A hot title reviewed recently in *Time Magazine* is *The Ninth Hour: A Novel* by three-time Pulitzer Prize finalist Alice McDermott. The author's forte is writing stories about Irish-American Catholics. In a Brooklyn tenement, an Irish immigrant commits suicide and leaves behind his pregnant wife. The Sisters of the Sick Poor take in Annie and her newborn daughter to work in the convent's laundry and offer support and hope for the future.

A World of Tomorrow by Brendan Mathews is also a well-reviewed novel. In June 1939, Francis Dempsey and his brother Michael steal money from the IRA. They escape to New York City where they reunite with their oldest brother Martin, now married and working as a jazz musician. The joyful reunion doesn't last long because a hitman from the IRA has followed them to the United States. The backdrop is the 1939 World's Fair and the Nazis marching through Europe.

Irish-born TV personality Graham Norton delivers his fiction writing debut with a cozy mystery, *Holding: A Novel* about a 26-year-old murder. In the Irish village of Duneen, the townsfolk are surprised to find the bones of Tommy Burke. They thought he had left town 26 years earlier. Was he murdered by his fiancée, Brid Riordan; by an old flame, Evelyn Ross; or by someone else?
