#### **Bonnie Easton**

Time for summer reading? Take a book to the beach or out to the patio to relax with a cold glass of your favorite beverage.

Let's talk series. *Lenin's Roller Coaster* by David Downing places spy Jack McColl in the middle of the 1917 Russian Revolution as he tries to find a way of using the events there to help the British defeat the Germans in World War I. He discovers his Irish-American girlfriend is also there as a journalist sympathetic to the Bolshevik cause. Will Jack and Caitlin's relationship survive on opposite sides of the philosophical spectrum? The author brings the history of espionage to life in this third edition of his series.

Murder at an Irish Wedding: An Irish Village Mystery by Carlene O'Connor brings back the O'Sullivan siblings to cater a celebrity wedding of a fashion model in their town. The best man is absent, so Siobhan's beau, garda Macdara Flannery, steps in. Both the best man and another member of the wedding party are discovered murdered, with Flannery as the prime suspect. Siobhan must clear his name and restore her town's honor.

*Cruel Winter: The County Cork Mysteries* by Sheila Connelly is the fifth in her series. It finds American Maura Donovan trapped in the pub she owns in County Cork during a rare snowstorm. One of her customers also trapped is the suspected killer of a decades' old unsolved murder. The locals decide to use the time to conduct their own mock trial and solve the crime. Will the police now review the case?






