BOOKBUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Selections for this month are by authors of literary fiction. Strong characters drive the stories rather than nonstop action.

Solar Bones by Mike McCormack takes readers into the spirit world. The spirit of Marcus Conway returns on All Souls Day to look back on his life. He remembers his hardworking father on the farm and his own life as a father, a husband, a civil engineer, and all of the events happening in the world around him that shaped his life and those of the people he loved.

In Paul Lynch's Grace: A Novel, Grace Coyle is just 14 years old when her pregnant mother hacks off her hair and dresses her in boys clothes to leave her home. Her mother is doing her a favor. It is 1845 at the beginning of Ireland's Great Famine. She learns survival skills as she scavenges, steals and hustles to cope in the world of hunger and death that surrounds her.

John Boyne (author of the children's book Boy in the Striped Pajamas) tells the story of Cyril Avery, an orphan who is adopted by an eccentric couple. He grows up in post-World War II Ireland. He fears being outed as a homosexual in a repressive country as he searches for his identity. His guardian angel, Mrs. Goggin, protects him as much as she can and offers advice that shapes his life. Both funny and tragic, the story intertwines the history of Ireland during this one man's life in The Heart's Invisible Furies.

They have a nomadic lifestyle as the author tells of misadventures in the Congo, cannibalism, the Wards' family life and Casement's covert homosexuality. As World War I approaches, Ward and his teenage son join the Army to fight the Germans. Casement works with the Germans to obtain guns to arm the Irish against their oppressors, the British. 




