



Let's talk about children's books this month.

A picture book for the little ones in your life is *Happy St. Patrick's Day* by Aimée Chapman, Penny Worms, and Kylie Hamley with illustrations by Nanette Regan. It will introduce children to the world of legends and faerie folk with shiny objects they can touch imbedded in the book. What does happen when you find a leprechaun?

For the eight-11 year-olds is the fantasy *The Storm Keeper's Island* by Catherine Doyle. The island of Arronmore chooses a new Storm Keeper each generation to command its power and protect its magic. Fionn's grandfather has held the job for many years, but he is ready to hand it off to another. Who among the island's most powerful families will take over and hold off the dark magic that threatens their lives?

Begone the Raggedy Witches by Celine Kiernan is Book 1 of the Wild Magic Trilogy fantasy series. Aimed at 11-13 year-olds, this book tells the story of raggedy witches who carry off Mup's father on the night their Aunty dies. Mup and her mother and her little brother enter the world of magic to save him from the evil witch who enforces her laws with terror and cruelty.

Love & Luck by Jenna Evans Welch offers teens a story about Addie, a broken-hearted 16 year-old girl, and her brother Ian. They arrive in Ireland for their aunt's destination wedding and tour the countryside, making unscheduled stops and attending a major music festival. As well as working on healing her heartbreak, she also must heal the fractured relationship between her and Ian.


