Bookbuzz Bonnie Easton

Here are some wonderful new additions to book series by authors that may be new to you.

Thirteen by Belfast-born Steve Cavanagh (cover title THIRTEEN) is the fourth in the Eddie Flynn legal thriller series. The previous titles are *The Defense*, *The Plea*, and *The Liar*. Eddie Flynn is a con artist turned lawyer who decided there isn't much difference between the two professions. In this installment, Robert Solomon of Hollywood's newest power couple is on trial for murdering his wife, but the real murderer may be a member of the jury.

London Tides by Carla Laureano is #2 in the *MacDonald Family Trilogy*. This Scottish romance trilogy also includes *Five Days in Skye* (#1) and *Under Scottish Stars* (#3). In this edition, Irish photojournalist Grace Brennan travels to the world's war zones, but the death of her friend and mentor leads her to search for the love of her life, Scottish businessman Ian MacDonald. She gave him up once to follow her career. Can she rekindle the flame?

The Mathematical Bridge by Jim Kelly is the second in the historical mystery series *Nighthawk*. In 1940, as World War II rages, Cambridge Detective Inspector Eden Brooke investigates the crime of a child who was put in a bag and thrown into the river. The latest migrants in the town are a close-knit group of Irish Catholics and a 5 year-old child is missing. An electronics factory is bombed and the IRA threatens more attacks during the impending visit by members of the royal family. The author offers a story of espionage with plenty of plot twists. The first book in the *Nighthawk* series is *The Great Darkness*.

The Scholar by Dervla McTiernan follows the first Cormac O'Reilly mystery, *The Ruin*. Cormac's girlfriend Emma finds the body of a dead girl who was the victim of an apparent hit-and-run. Caroline Darcy was the heir to the profitable pharmaceutical company, Darcy Therapeutics. Cormac is under pressure to find the murderer, but he must consider the possibility that Emma may be involved. She was suspected of murder once before.

Belle was born the oldest of three daughters in a military garrison. She is the toast of Victorian London in 1887 as an entertainer with one of her sisters playing high society clubs. By 1891, she falls in love with Irish aristocrat William, Viscount Dunlo, and becomes the Countess of Clancarty, but his father doesn't approve of the match. She finds herself vilified in the press and on trial attempting to save her reputation.

Theresa Argie, The Haunted Housewife

Theresa Argie, *The Haunted Housewife*, will join us at 7 pm, Friday, August 16 in the Phil Walsh Cabaret Room to discuss her most recent book and ghost hunting experiences in the Cleveland area. This is an exciting new event at the Club that you won't want to miss! Admission is \$10 at the door.

Theresa Argie's father, Patrick J. Gallagher, emigrated from County Mayo in the 1950s. Theresa and her family grew up immersed in the Irish culture. As a child, she spent years involved with the West Side Irish American Club. She married a wonderful man with strong family roots and a mutual love for Ireland. Today, Theresa and her husband Jay are proud members of the IACES.


Theresa makes her living as an author and public speaker. She often works with Cathi Weber, aka "The Ghost Lady" of Lake County. Besides their work on the Willoughby Ghost Walk, the ladies are heavily involved with various fundraising events and historic preservation projects. Theresa has penned two books; *America's Most Haunted* (Penguin Random House 2014) and her latest, *Love Beyond the Grave: True Tales of Haunted Hearts* (Hestia Media 2018). Theresa shares stories from her new book as well as her personal adventures as a ghost hunter and paranormal investigator. Hear about exotic locations and local hotspots with Cleveland's own *Haunted Housewife*. *Love Beyond the Grave* is a collection of real people, actual events, and historic characters whose stories revolve around a common theme of love. But love can take many forms and manifest in remarkable ways; sometimes it can be dangerous or even deadly. This powerful emotion can defy logic and transcend physical death. Beyond normal, each story has a paranormal element. The author explores the tragic, traumatic, and sometimes terrifying elements of these famous tales of love. Examples include: An eccentric couple whose love was so strong, neither distance nor death could keep them apart; a rich playboy seduces a naive farm girl, leading to her inevitable fall from grace, tragic death, and restless afterlife; a tenacious mother, fueled by love and unshakeable resolve, helps her murdered daughter find justice from beyond the grave; a deadly love triangle that made headlines, inspired Hollywood, and crushed the soul of "America's Sweetheart"; the dark side of paradise, where one man's morbid obsession turned a beautiful young girl into a gruesome science experiment; a beautiful castle in Ireland, haunted by young lovers caught in the middle of warring clans; and an entire chapter devoted to animals, remarkable creatures who remain loving and loyal long after leaving this mortal coil. These are just a sampling of the stories included in *Love Beyond the Grave: True Tales of Haunted Hearts*. The people are real, the events historic, and the ghost stories leave even the most skeptical reader scratching their head.
