Many libraries are offering limited services now with curbside or drive through pick up for materials, and still provide wonderful digital resources for home use such as eBooks, eAudio books, online magazines, research databases, streaming music and movies, and online classes. Here are some reading suggestions that you should be able to find in eBook format for the summer.

The Pull of the Stars: A Novel by Emma Donoghue is a very timely offering. Donoghue is writing about the flu epidemic of 1918 just as World War I is ending and soldiers are returning home. Nurses are stretched to their limits caring for pregnant flu victims in Dublin in the midst of political uncertainty. Art imitates life.

Death at Whitewater Church by Andrea Carter is the first in a proposed series called the Inishowen Mysteries. Benedicto (Ben) O'Keeffe is a solicitor for the owner of a deconsecrated church when a skeleton is found wrapped in a blanket and left in a hidden crypt. Local gossip proclaims it is Conor Devitt who went missing six years earlier on his wedding day, but evidence negates that theory. So where is Conor and who is the skeleton in the crypt? Ben investigates.

The Crooked Branch by Jeanine Cummins is the story of two mothers living in two different periods of history, each with their own problems to solve. Ginny is a young mother who is struggling to survive during the Famine in Ireland and her husband Raymond is trying to make a living in America. In the present day, Majella and Leo have just brought home their first child. Frazzled mother Majella finds the diary of her ancestor, Ginny, in the attic. There, she discovers a murder occurred in her family.

The Transatlantic Book Club by Felicity Hayes-McCoy continues the saga of the people on the fictional Finfarran Peninsula. Cassie Fitzgerald wants to cheer up her grandmother who was recently widowed, so she persuades a librarian to set up a book club on Skype to gather several of her old friends who emigrated to America. Maybe she went too far because the participants are bringing up old grudges. *The Irish Princess* by Karen Harper is the tale set in the tumultuous times of Henry VIII. Elizabeth Fitzgerald, or Gera, is the daughter of Irish nobleman, the Earl of Kildare, but Henry imprisons him and tears her family apart. She flees to the English court and seeks revenge in the intrigue of court politics to restore her family's honor. Also, she attempts to protect Henry's young daughter, Princess Elizabeth.


