


BOOKBUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Two renowned Irish-born authors have written new books that explore a culture very different from their own.

Apeirogon: A Novel by National Book Award-winning author Colum McCann is the story of two fathers, one Pakistani and one Israeli, who each lost a beloved daughter in the region's never-ending war. The two fathers join forces to fight for peace in this fictionalized tale of real people.

The Girl, by 89 year-old author Edna O'Brien, takes place in Nigeria in 2014 when schoolgirls were abducted by Boko Haram. Their treatment in captivity was barbaric. O'Brien personalizes their story by focusing on one young woman, Maryam, who struggles to survive and escapes with a child conceived by one of her kidnappers.

Cork-born author Jean Grainger offers a series of two paperbacks that tell the story of a mother in Nazi Germany who sends her two Jewish children on the Kindertransport to save their lives. *The Star and the Shamrock* and *The Emerald Horizon* trace the lives of Ariella and her children, Liesl and Erich, who must separate. The children stay with a relative in Belfast while their mother hides in an attic of a woman who is concealing her from her own husband and son, who is a soldier in the Third Reich. Will the three be reunited when the war ends?

Bestselling author Dervla McTiernan has churned out the third entry in her Cormac Reilly series. Three unconnected events are linked by the small town of Roundstone: police corruption, an investigation that ends in tragedy, and a mysterious little girl who won't utter a sound. Cormac faces enemies at work and Garda Peter Fisher is sent to Roundstone to work under his overbearing father.
