BOOKBUZZ

We are now starting another summer month. Here are a few selections for your patio reading.

Treacherous Strand by Andrea Carter is a character-driven mystery set on the Inishowen Peninsula in County Donegal. The body of a French woman who was living nearby is found on a beach and her death is dismissed as a suicide. Second in the author's Inishowen series, amateur sleuth and solicitor Bendicta O'Keeffe believes the death is a murder.

Saltwater is the debut novel of Jessica Andrews. Twenty-fiveyear-old Lucy Bailey was uprooted from England to Ireland to live with her grandparents after her alcoholic father left her and her mother. She reflects on her life of trying to fit in during her high school and college years.

A Slip of a Girl by poet Patricia Reilly Giff is a children's book written in verse. It takes place during the Land Wars in Ireland in 1879-1882 when families were thrown off their farms. Young Anna Mallon sees their potatoes hit by blight. Then her mother dies and her brothers emigrate to America, leaving her with her

father and special needs sister. The story is loosely based on the life of the author's grandmother.

The Golden Grave: A Rose Gallagher Mystery is the second in a historical mystery series by Erin Lindsey. Former maid, Rose Gallagher, is a newly hired Pinkerton agent during the Golden Age of Manhattan. Who killed six delegates to a political convention? Rose and her partner, Thomas Wiltshire, are on the case. The next victim may be Theodore Roosevelt.


