Happy Fall! Time to curl up under your favorite afghan with a good book. Let's pick up a few choices from this summer by well-known Irish authors.

Grown Ups by chick lit author Marian Keyes is the story of the three Casey brothers - Johnny, Ed, and Liam and their wives and children. Basically, they are happy and healthy and present themselves as a close-knit family. Then Ed's wife, Cara, has a concussion and begins to tell all the family's well-kept secrets that were meant to be kept secret. Where do they go from here?

Home by Roddy Doyle talks about male friendship, aging, and guilt. Two childhood mates, Joe and Davy, meet for an epic pub crawl. Davy is visiting from his home in London to see his dying father. He left Dublin to escape his dad's continuous disapproval. Joe recently left his wife and children for another woman, a girl with a cello they had both yearned for in their youth. They are trying to justify their life decisions to each other as well as to themselves. By closing time, they have discovered that love takes many forms.

A friend recommended Jeanne Gainger's book, *Sisters of the Southern Cross*. Based on her extensive research, the author tells the story of Sister Claire McAuliffe and four other sisters who travel from County Waterford to do God's work in Queensland, Australia in 1900. They run a Catholic school to educate the children of Gold Rush families. The climate and challenges of the land with its bugs, crocodiles, and snakes terrify her, but she also fears the well-respected mayor of the town. There is just something in his manner that causes her concern, particularly in his attitude toward the aborigines.


