

BOOKBUZZ

Fall has arrived. Enjoy the trees changing color and the crisp, cooler air and reading new books.

Bestselling Irish mystery writer, Tana French, offers her newest book, another standalone not in the Murder Squad series, on October 6. *The Searcher* tells the story of a retired, newly divorced Chicago cop who buys a rundown cottage in a small Irish town. As he tries to renovate it and settle into a new life, young Trey enlists his help in finding his missing brother, Brendan, but he doesn't want to involve the local police.

In *Celtic Crossing: A Novel*, author Len Mattano explores the realm of healing and holy relics. Jesuit priest, Father Kevin Schaeffer, is on sabbatical in Ireland when he hears of a boy dying of leukemia. The boy's mother asks his help in finding a family cross that has healed her family's misfortunes for generations. His journey takes him through the stories of Saints Patrick and Brigid while tracking the lives of both Mary Magdalene and Mary, the mother of Jesus.

The last two books have a common theme: the history of jewelry. In *No Stone Unturned* by Andrea Kane, Fiona McKay is studying the jewels in an ancient tapestry for her new line of Celtic jewelry. Her mentor, Rose Flaherty, had information for her, but when Fiona arrives for a visit, she finds the old woman dead. She enlists the help of her brother, Ryan, and his girlfriend, Claire, to unravel the clues woven into the tapestry and find the murderer. Of course, an IRA assassin is involved.

American jewelry historian, Kate Kirby, adored her Irish grandmother, Essie, in *The Lost Jewels: A Novel* by Kristy Manning. Essie and her siblings grew up in poverty as immigrants with an alcoholic mother in Cheapside, England after her father died in 1912. Kate is sent to London to research the Cheapside jewels, but she finds sketches left by her grandmother that look exactly like the missing jewels she is researching. In this fictionalized account of a true story, there is a mystery to solve. The tale crisscrosses time periods and locations. 


















Membership Has Its Privileges


