BOOKBUZZ

Here are a few new books for your reading pleasure this month. The debut novel by Dianna Rostad is **You Belong to Me**. Three orphans are put on a train in New York City to travel west. An Irish boy orphaned by the Spanish flu, a little girl who doesn't speak, and an older hotheaded boy who lied about his age and is wanted for a crime in New York. The three of them band together to run away while in Montana in 1925. They are taken in by a spinster on a cattle ranch. Although she makes them work hard, she begins to take on a motherly role and tries to protect them when the oldest boy is arrested and could face hanging.

Maeve, an aspiring young actress, meets Murtaugh Moone in 1978 while they are students at Trinity College. *The Dazzling Truth: A Novel* by Helen Cullen traces their relationship through 37 years of marriage on a small Irish island as their four children take separate paths and the family drifts apart, but a dazzling truth brings them all together again.

Samantha Power, a former Ambassador to the United Nations and a Pulitzer Prize winning author for *A Problem from Hell: America and the Age of Genocide*, offers the story of her life so far in *The Education of an Idealist: A Memoir*. She was born in London to Irish parents and lived in Dublin until she was nine. She became a U. S. citizen in 1993 and earned a BA from Harvard and a law degree from Yale. In her memoir, she tells the story of her years as a war correspondent before entering the field of national security and world diplomacy, while juggling her professional life with her responsibilities of being a wife and a mother of two young children.

The bestselling author of *American Dirt*, Jeanine Cummins, has rereleased a couple of her earlier books that have Irish influences. *The Outside Boy*, published in 2010, centers on an Irish Pavee gypsy boy whose mother died in childbirth. Now he and his father roam from town to town in a wagon that holds their possessions. Their lives change forever when they discover his mother's mysterious past. *The Crooked Branch*, originally released in 2013, takes place in two different time periods. In modern day Queens, a sleep-deprived new mother finds the diary of her maternal grandmother, Ginny Doyle, who fled the Irish famine. Majella is determined to find the truth behind her grandmother's story and why she called herself a murderer in her diary.






