BOOKBUZZ

The holidays are once again upon us. They seem to come around faster every year, don't they? Here are some reading suggestions for you this December.

Let's start with a couple of new biographies about Irish American politicians.

The Luckiest Man: Life with John McCain is a memoir by the senator's most trusted friend, Mark Salter. He covers McCain's childhood, his naval service, and his 36-year political career. Salter recounts events in his friend's life, like moving 20 times as the military brat of a four-star admiral, his five-and-a-half years as a prisoner of war in Vietnam, and his rise to power in the Senate and failed race for the presidency.

Catching the Wind: Edward Kennedy and the Liberal Hour by prolific biographer Neal Gabler is the story of the rise to power by the youngest brother in the Kennedy dynasty. He lived through the death of his charismatic older brother Joseph and the assassinations of brothers John and Robert to become arguably America's most powerful senator in history. This is the first of two proposed volumes.

Here are a few new works of fiction:

The Traveller and Other Stories by mystery writer Stuart Neville offers 12 short stories that take place in Northern Ireland. The stories include chilling tales of horror and noir thrillers.

Exciting Times by Naoise Dolan features a young Irish expat living in Hong Kong. Ava is caught in a love triangle with shy banker, Julian, and affectionate lawyer, Edith. Which one will fit best into her lifestyle?

Booker Prize Winner John Banville has written a mystery novel, *Snow*, set in a country manor in 1957 County Wexford. Detective Inspector John Stratford, a Protestant, is called in during a raging snowstorm to solve the murder of a Catholic priest.


