Here are three novels that you might enjoy reading this summer.

Northern Spy: A Novel by Flynn Berry is a contemporary thriller whose main character is a single mother working as a producer for the BBC. Tessa watches a video of three IRA terrorists robbing a bank and recognizes her younger sister, Marian, who she thought was out of the country on vacation. What is more important - her family bond, or her dedication to reporting the news?

Charles Todd (mother and son writing team of Charles and Caroline Todd) writes two series of mysteries, Inspector Ian Rutledge and Bess Crawford, plus other stand-alone novels. The latest installment of the World War I nurse Bess Crawford series is *An Irish Hostage: A Novel.* After the end of World War I, Bess travels to Ireland for the wedding of her friend, nurse Eileen Flynn, and Michael Sullivan, both of whom played a part in the Easter Rising of 1916. They are on the run because they are considered traitors by the British government. Michael disappears and now Bess must figure out who to trust to save herself and stop a killer.

A Dance in Donegal by Jennifer Diebel is a Christian historical romance. Moire Doherty promised her late mother that she would go to Ballymann, the town where her mother grew up, and become a teacher. She travels to the small Irish town, meets handsome thatcher Sean McFadden, and discovers a scandal that involved her mother.
