BOOKBUZZ

Among this month's selections are two biographies.

Brat: An 80s Story by Irish American actor/director Andrew McCarthy tells of the struggles and successes of a member of the 80s Brat Pack. He starred in *St. Elmo's Fire* and *Pretty in Pink* and was a director of several episodes of *Orange Is the New Black*. McCarthy abused alcohol to cope with fame in Hollywood and with his own insecurities. Now, he is lauded as a travel writer and the author of the 2012 book, *The Longest Way Home*.

Sinéad O'Connor offers *Remembrances* to tell the story of the controversies in her life. In her words, she says tearing up the photograph of John Paul II on *Saturday Night Live* "derailed my career." Fame caught up with her when she released a version of Prince's "Nothing Compares 2 U" while dealing with her own mental illness and raising four children by four different fathers. She found peace by converting to Islam.

Letters Across the Sea: A Novel by Canadian author Genevieve Graham takes place during the 1930s as the Nazis in Europe rise to power and the Depression continues to hold a grip on the economy. In Toronto, Hitler's ideology spreads and tensions boil over between the Irish and the Jews. Molly Ryan's best friend is Hannah Dreyfus who introduces her to her handsome older brother Max, a Jewish medical student. As her relationship with Max deepens, she starts a new job as a reporter for a local paper and "No Jews Allowed" signs appear around the city.

Elizabeth McCracken offers a book of short stories with the common theme of family bonds. *Souvenir Museum: Stories* follows an arc of stories that starts with "The Irish Wedding" about Jewish American Sadie and her boyfriend Jack traveling to Ireland for his sister's wedding and meeting his British family for the first time. The last story ends 20 years later when they reignite their relationship. There are 12 stories in all.










