BOOKBUZZ

Are you ready for some new books to take to the beach or pool?

Let's start with the debut novel by Tracey Lange. We Are the Brennans traces the lives of an Irish Catholic family through the eyes of Sunday Brennan who had left her home in New York State for sunny Southern California five years earlier. After driving drunk and landing in the hospital, she finds her brother, Denny, at her bedside and has no choice but to return home with him. Family secrets come tumbling out as Denny and his business partner, Sunday's ex-boyfriend, fight to save the family's Irish pub from the clutches of a loan shark.

The Elephant of Belfast: A Novel by S. Kirk Walsh is a fictionalized account of a true story about zookeeper, Hettie Quinn. In 1940, the city is living through the horrors of the Belfast Blitz as the Germans bomb the city relentlessly. Instead of heading to a shelter when air raid sirens sound as she should, Hettie runs to comfort the animals in the zoo, especially their newly arrived elephant, Violet. With the help of her brother-in-law, a member of the IRA, she stashes the elephant with an order of nuns for safekeeping.

Irish novelist Emily Hourican recounts the lives of three heiresses of the Guinness fortune in the early 1900s as a world war rages in Europe, Padraic Pearse leads the 1916 Rising, and the Irish civil war breaks out. *The Glorious Guinness Girls* tells the story of the carefree lives of the beautiful and wealthy Aileen, Maureen, and Oonagh and compares them to the political upheaval in Ireland during the same period.

Another book on the Kennedys? *The Ambassador: Joseph P. Kennedy at the Court of St. James* covers millionaire entrepreneur Joseph P. Kennedy, Sr. when Franklin D. Roosevelt sent him to London as the American ambassador. His appointment was controversial at the time and this biography is not flattering. He is presented as an anti-Semite and an inept diplomat with political ambitions. He angered the British by proclaiming that they would never defeat the Nazis. His diplomatic career ended in 1940. With his own political hopes dashed, he passed the torch on to his sons.




