

#### **BOOK BUZZ**

Here is a preview of three books that are scheduled to be released Tuesday, September 7.

The Magician: A Novel by Colm Toibin (Brooklyn) is a factionalized biography of the Nobel Prize winning German novelist Thomas Mann. Toibin chronicles the life of this Jewish novelist from his escape from the Nazis to America during World War II. Although he married and fathered six children, his personal journals, quoted in the novel by Toibin, show his homosexual yearnings.

The House of Ashes by Stuart Neville is a psychological thriller about a family who moves from England to Belfast for a "fresh start" after the wife's nervous breakdown. Sarah Keane finds herself stuck in a new town, friendless and jobless, and living in a house with a mysterious traumatic history. A Northern Irish farm girl who lived in the house 50 years ago is telling Sarah her story and an old woman in blood-soaked clothing is banging on her door.

**Beautiful World, Where Are You** by Sally Rooney (*Normal People*) is the story of a successful novelist, her friend, and their lovers in Ireland and in an excursion to Rome. As we peek into their private lives, we also hear their discussions about culture, climate, change, and politics.

A nonfiction book recently released is *Irish Assassins: Conspiracy, Revenge, and the Phoenix Park Murders That Stunned Victorian England* by Julie Kavanagh, a true crime page turner. Republican militants murdered Lord Frederick Cavendish and Thomas Burke, the British chief secretary and undersecretary to Ireland. The assassinations were financed by Irish Americans and exposed the treatment of the poor in England to the world and delayed Home Rule for 30 years.

And for those who love cookbooks, *The Ultimate Irish Cookbook: 111 Dishes from Ireland to Cook Right Now* by Slovka Bodic. It is one in a series of ethnic cookbooks. The author features hearty Irish favorites from scones and soda breads to colcannon and stews.


