Let's start with a seasonal selection. *An Irish Country Yuletide* by Patrick Taylor is the sixteenth entry in the author's Irish Country series. It takes place in 1965 in the fictional town of Ballybucklebo. Dr. O'Reilly has promised to play Santa while there is an outbreak of chicken pox threatening and the townspeople are dealing with their own personal challenges. Taylor even includes holiday recipes.

John Banville has dropped his pseudonym, Benjamin Black, for his Quirke mystery series and is writing it under his own name. His newest offering is *April in Spain*. Dublin pathologist Quirke is vacationing with his wife when he injures his hand and needs treatment at a local hospital. The attending physician is an Irish woman who looks exactly like a woman killed many years ago by her brother. The murder caused quite a scandal for a prominent political family at the time. Maybe an investigation is called for?

A timely arrival is *56 Days: A Thriller* by Catherine Ryan Howard. As COVID-19 lockdowns are put in place, a young couple becomes romantically involved and decides to move in together. Fifty-six days later, police respond to reports of a foul odor coming from their apartment and discover a decomposing body in the shower. There is no identification on the deceased and the clues are inconsistent.

The Month of Borrowed Dreams by Felicity Hayes-McCoy (The Library at the Edge of the World, Summer at the Garden Cafe, The Mistletoe Matchmaker, and The Transatlantic Book Club) has another story to tell about the inhabitants of the fictional Finfarran Peninsula on the west coast of Ireland. Librarian Hanna Casey is content with her job and her love interest Brian before her cheating ex-husband Malcolm shows up in their quiet town and she also finds out that Brian has a grown son that he failed to mention previously. Her assistant and his fiancée are planning a double wedding with friends, but plans are not going smoothly. Hanna's daughter, Jazz, was dumped by her boyfriend. In the meantime, the library staff is starting a book/movie club for its patrons where attendees will discuss the differences between the book and its film counterpart. There will be a happily-ever-after ending, right?
