BOOK BUZZ

I hope you enjoy this month's selections:

The Saint Patrick's Battalion, also known as the San Patricios of the Mexican American War, are featured in the new historical romance novel by Reyna Grande titled *A Ballad of Love and Glory*. An Irish immigrant named John Riley joins the U.S. Army, but he is shocked by the way his fellow Irishmen are treated and by the atrocities against Mexicans committed by American soldiers. He deserts his unit and swims the Rio Grande River to join the Mexican Army. He forms a battalion of Europeans fighting for Mexico. Riley falls in love with a Mexican nurse whose husband was killed by American soldiers.

William Kent Krueger has written 17 mysteries in his Cork O'Connor series set in Minnesota. In his 18th entry in the series, Krueger offers a prequel, *Lightning Strike*, that features Cork's father, Sheriff Liam O'Connor in a 1963 murder case. There is conflict between O'Connor's Irish heritage and his wife's family of Ojibwe Indians. Young Cork, only 12 years old, must balance both sides of his ancestry to live in their town. and helps his father solve his case.

The Torque Man: A. Novel by Peter Mann is set during the last three years of Third Reich. Mann relates the tale of two manuscripts found in Berlin in September 1945, each of which tells a different version of the life of an Irish spy. In one story, he is a charismatic IRA fighter who escapes captivity in Spain. In the second, he is an Allied saboteur with a mission to assassinate high-ranking Nazi doctors, including Hitler's personal physician. So, who is the real Frank Pike?

If we had the technology, would you edit your memories and delete all the hurtful parts that cause you pain? *Tell Me an Ending* by Jo Hardin explores such possibilities as it follows several characters who are faced with deciding which memories to keep and which to forget. Nepenthe is a company run by a psychologist that specializes in memory removal, but they are confronted by their clients who are beginning to have traces of memories they thought were erased. Do you change your present if you can't remember your past?
