BOOK BUZZ

As summer approaches, let's take a look at a variety of books that have come out recently.

First on the list is a publication of 16 essays by a versatile Irish author, the late Seamus Deane. *Small World: Ireland, 1798-2018* covers a wide variety of topics in Irish life from political, literary, and historical viewpoints.

Good Eggs: A Novel is a humorous debut by Rebecca Hardiman. Kevin Gogarty's 83-year-old mother needs a caretaker to watch her after she is caught shoplifting again. Kevin has lost his job, but his wife jets off to exotic locations for her work and leaves him to cope with his sulky teenaged daughter who is getting into mischief. The new aide whom he hires is a welcome delight until she causes a new family crisis.

Sarah Stewart Taylor offers the first three books in her Maggie D'arcy mystery series. Maggie is a Long Island homicide detective whose cases involve missing persons and murder and take her to Dublin, the Irish coast of West Cork, and a small town in County Clare for her investigations. She brings along her teenage daughter, Lilly. The titles are *The Mountains Wild*, *A Distant Grave*, and *The Drowning Sea*.

For those of you with little ones in grades 1-4 who want to introduce them to a bit of Irish history this summer, there is the Little Library series by author John Burke and illustrator Fatti Burke. Together, they have created *Brian Boru: The Warrior King*, *Granuaile: The Pirate Queen*, *Constance Markievicz: The Rebel Countess*, *Tom Crean: The Brave Explorer*, and *Mary Robinson: A Voice for*

Fairness. All are 32 pages long, just the right length for young minds.
