Mystery/thrillers take center stage this month.

Rhys Bowen and her daughter, Clare Brayles, collaborated on *Wild Irish Rose* for another entry in the Molly Murphy series. Molly Murphy Sullivan has moved to New York City in 1907 and is seeing family and friends once again. She visits Ellis Island with a friend. Her husband, Daniel, is a policeman who comes home to tell her of a murder of a woman there that afternoon and the suspected killer looks exactly like Molly. Although she is no longer a private detective, she must investigate and clear her name.

Dervla McTiernan, born in Ireland where she worked as a lawyer for 12 years, offers *The Murder Rule*. This psychological thriller features a third-year law school student, Hannah Rokeby. She transfers to the University of Virginia to participate in the Innocence Project to study the cases of death row inmates. One case involves a report in which her own mother claimed a man had raped her and killed her boyfriend in 1994. Was her mother telling the truth at the trial?

Award-winning Northern Irish author, Adrian McKinty, has written a new thriller set in Australia. In *The Island*, Tom, a doctor, and his new much younger wife take his two daughters on an adventurous vacation to help the girls recover from the recent death of their mother. Tom drives too fast and runs over a woman and the family hides the body to cover their crime. The dead woman's family captures them and kills Tom, leaving the new wife and her stepdaughters to escape across the scorching desert. Lots of plot twists to surprise you.

Lady Annabeth de Lacey wishes to be apprenticed to Stephen Jennings in *Lady of Galway Manor* by Jennifer Diebel. Stephen runs the family jewelry store and is a descendant of the creator of the original Claddagh ring. The year is 1920, just as Ireland's political events are leading the country to their War of Independence. Stephen hates the British aristocracy and all that Annabeth represents. She looks down on the Irish "peasantry," but is anxious to learn all she can about Irish history and culture. Sparks fly. Great scene for a romance, right?


