BOOK BUZZ

New selections for your reading pleasure this month... Convicted IRA bank robber Richard O'Rawe is a new author on the fiction scene. His first book, *Northern Heist* (2021), is a thriller based on a still unsolved bank robbery committed in 2004. In O'Rawe's novel, James "Runctions" O'Hare, a former member of the IRA, plans a kidnapping and a bank heist in Belfast, but when his IRA friends get wind of the scheme, they want their cut and complications arise. Kangaroo courts, money laundering, and drug deals follow.

O'Rawe's newest entry in the O'Hare series is *Goering's Gold* (2022). This time, O'Hare is entangled in a plot to find missing gold left by Hermann Goering during World War II. Evidence points to it being hidden in Ireland, but O'Hare would still be in danger there with the IRA over his previous bank heist conflict. The author promises lots of plot twists and turns in this thriller, including encounters with the IRA and Neo-Nazis.

Billy O'Callaghan offers a novel titled *Life Sentences* that covers three generations of the Martin family in Ireland. Broken into three parts, O'Callaghan weaves together the lives of Nancy Martin's family from Nancy's love affair with the gardener and her life as an unwed mother living in poverty, her son's struggles after World War I, and her granddaughter, Nellie, as her health begins to fail in 1982. The story is loosely based on the stories and survival of the author's own family.

Seven Steeples by Sara Baume tells of the social experiment of a young couple, Bell (Isabel) and Sigh (Simon), who wish to live in solitude. They live together for eight years with their dogs at the foot of a mountain in the Irish countryside where they are isolated from friends and family. Their retreat leads to self reliance in their little cabin with a garden. The simplicity of daily life binds them closer together.
