BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Three bestselling Irish authors released new historical fiction books late this year.

Maggie O'Farrell, the author of *Hamnet*, published her new book, *The Marriage Portrait*. She investigates the mysterious death of a bride in the 16th century, Lucretia de'Medici, who died at the age of 16. She married her late sister's fiancé, Alfonso, the Duke of Ferrera and dies soon afterwards. Did Alfonso kill his young bride? O'Farrell attempts to solve this historical mystery.

Patti Callahan (*Becoming Mrs. Lewis*) offers *Once Upon a Wardrobe*. An eight-year-old boy named George, who is often confined to bed with a weak heart, has just read Lewis' new book about the children's trip to Narnia through a wardrobe. His older sister helps him contact the author so that he can ask him questions about how his story was created. Megs is a brilliant physics student at Oxford and doesn't believe in fantasy, but she helps her little brother out of her love for him.

Emma Donoghue (*Wonder*) returns with her newest book, *Haven: A Novel*. She is writing the story of the founding of Skellig Michael off the coast of Ireland. In the 7th century, three men, a priest and two monks, row down the River Shannon looking for a spot to found a monastery. They discover an isolated island made up of steep rocks that are possessed by birds. There, on the top of the mountain, they found a monastery whose remains still exist today.
