BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

The lead singer of the Irish rock band U2 released his memoir this fall. Bono tells his story of growing up in Dublin in the 70s, the influence of his family, the loss of his mother when he was 14, and his activist work fighting AIDS and extreme poverty.

All the Broken Places by Irish author John Boyne takes the characters from his bestselling young adult novel **The Boy in** *the Striped Pajamas* into present day London with flashbacks to World War II. When Gretel, now 92, meets her new neighbors—a father, a mother, and their young son—in her apartment building, she suspects the father of abusing his family. She starts having flashbacks to living with her own father, the commandant of Auschwitz, and the horrors that she observed there. The psychological trauma of those memories brings back feelings of guilt and shame. She survived when so many others did not.

Michelle Gallen offers her second novel after *Big Girl, Small Town*. Maeve is looking for a summer job in Belfast in Northern Ireland in 1994. She and her two friends need to find jobs and hope to enroll in university in the fall if they passed their leaving exams. Then they can leave their small, boring town. What the three Catholic teenagers find in working at the shirt factory is prejudice against them by their Protestant coworkers and a sleazy English boss who sleeps with his employees. The backdrop of the story is the violence of The Troubles in Northern Ireland.




