Today is another chilly, rainy day in Northeast Ohio, a great chance to curl up with a good book and a cup of hot tea. Here are a few suggestions you may want to grab.

In Jean Grainger's Kilteegan Bridge series of five books, the author traces the lives of Lena and Eli Kogan and their family through World War II Germany in the 1930s and 40s, rural Ireland in the 1950s, and County Cork in the 1970s. The five titles to this saga are 1. *The Trouble with Secrets*, 2. *What Divides Us*, 3. *More Harm Than Good*, 4. *When Irish Eyes Are Lying*, and 5. *A Silent Understanding*.

Cora Harrison offers *The Deadly Weed*, the tenth installment of her *Reverend Mother* series set in County Cork. When the Reverend Mother's second cousin, Robert Murphy, opens a cigarette factory near her school, ten of her girls find jobs there rolling cigarettes. A local man, who is a known drunk, dies of smoke inhalation when the privy at the plant catches fire. One of the students, Maureen McCarthy, is accused of arson and murder. Can the Reverend Mother clear her of the charges?

Murder at an Irish Castle by Ellie Brannigan is the first of the author's new *An Irish Castle Mystery* series. The main character is Rodeo Drive bridalwear designer Rayne McGrath. On her thirtieth birthday, she expected a romantic dinner and a marriage proposal, but, instead, she finds her bridal shop robbed, her fiancé missing, and her bank account drained. Her late Uncle Nevin leaves her a run-down castle in a small town in Ireland. Without the castle, the townspeople will lose their livelihood. She promises to stay in Ireland for a year to help. Of course, there is also a possible murder in the castle for her to solve as well.


