BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Let's catch up on some recently released nonfiction books.

There Will Be Fire: Margaret Thatcher, the IRA, and Two Minutes That Changed History by journalist Rory Carroll tells the gripping tale of October 12, 1984, when the IRA attempted to assassinate Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher at a Conservative Party Conference. By gathering information from over 100 interviews, the author constructs a timeline that reads like a thriller.

Bad Bridget: Crime, Mayhem and Lives of Irish Emigrant Women by Leanne McCormack and Elaine Farrell is the story of young Irish women who traveled to America alone. They left a country where women often outnumbered men in prisons and they could be locked up just for being stubborn, but American cities often did not treat them any better.

We have all heard of the coffin ships that brought over many of our ancestors during the famine. What were those voyages like? ***The Coffin Ship: Life and Death at Sea during the Great Famine*** by Cian T. McMahon uses letters and diaries written by the passengers between 1845-1855 who were trying to escape the famine and begin a new life.

Old Ireland in Colour and ***Old Ireland in Colour II*** by author John Breslin and historian Sarah-Anne Buckley are books of colorized and restored photos from the 19th and 20th centuries. They cover the Irish Civil War of the 1920s, the beauty of the four provinces of Ireland, and people's everyday life, as well as the lives of the Irish abroad.

Ireland Travel Guide 2023: The Most Complete Pocket Guide to Discover Ireland by Mike Darcey is an alternative to the standard guides produced by Fodor's, Frommer's, or Rick Steves. It offers insider tips on restaurants, places to visit, and hotels. The author has your itineraries prepared for you all packaged with gorgeous photos.

I must add one fiction book, just because I am seeing it mentioned everywhere. ***The Rachel Incident*** by Irish author and podcaster Caroline O'Donoghue takes us to a bookstore in Cork during the financial crisis of 2010 where 20-something student Rachel and her gay bookstore co-worker, James, are roommates. She yearns for her married college professor, Fred Byrne, but Fred yearns for James. The situation leads to an amusing love triangle.



