#### **BOOK BUZZ**

The Booker Prize Winner for 2023 is *Prophet Song* by Paul Lynch (*Grace, Red Sky Morning*). It's a story with a dystopian bent in which Ireland finds itself a country that has chosen an authoritarian government with militant secret police. Larry Stuck is arrested for participating in a protest march in favor of trade unions. His wife, Eilish, and their children believe he has been killed, but she still refuses to move to somewhere safer. She is caring for her father who has dementia and swears at the soldiers. When one of her sons is tortured to death and she must claim his body, she considers whether to leave the country to the "thugs" who are running it.

The setting for *The Half Moon: A Novel* by Mary Beth Keane (*Ask Again, Yes; Fever*) is a bar in suburban New York. Malcolm has bought a bar from his former boss who had decided to retire. His wife is a lawyer and the breadwinner in the family. They thought they would have children someday, but they can't seem to slow down long enough to get around to it. Malcolm has sunk everything into the bar without discussing any of it with his wife. Finally, his wife walks out, leaving them to tackle the problems in their marriage and accept their disappointments.

*The Ballad of Lord Edward and Citizen Small* by award-winning Irish film director Neil Jordan is historical fiction based on a friendship between a British Army Officer from a wealthy Anglo-Irish family and his former enslaved companion. The story begins in South Carolina in 1781 during the American Revolution when Tony Small saves Lord Edward Fitzgerald's life. Tony becomes Fitzgerald's friend and manservant. They travel together back to Dublin and play a role in the Rebellion of 1798 on the side of the United Irishmen. The story is told from Small's point of view.

**Unforgettable, A Legal Thriller** by Deborah Hawkins revolves around Cameron Rhodes, a 45-year-old partner in a law firm in Ireland. He is the grandson of one of the firm's founders and son of one of their current chief litigants. In walks the beautiful Raven Adair, also a solicitor, who wants to hire him to defend her father, Lachlan Adair, a famous poet and patriot, who is accused of killing his actress wife. Cam's mother and the family matriarch believes her husband is havng an affair and commits suicide. There are attempts on Cam's life, so he sends his wife and daughters away for their safety. He can't resist Raven, also a suspect in the actress' death, and has an affair. The motive proposed for Lachlan to kill his wife was that she was blocking his multimillionaire dollar sequel to his hit movie, **Unforgettable**. Raven is desperate to keep her father out of prison, but she reveals that her father is a former IRA gunman, adding even more fuel to the fire. All evidence points to Lachlan's guilt. Oh! What a tangled web we weave! Lots of twists and turns in this one.


