

Bookbuzz Bonnie Easton

Can you believe we're heading into the holiday season already? Here are a few reading selections as the cold weather approaches.

Tana French, the superb Irish crime writer, is back! After five Dublin Murder Squad mysteries, she offers her first stand-alone mystery, *The Witch Elm: A Novel*. French delivers the suspenseful novel of a charming young social media expert who surprises two burglars in his apartment after a night of drinking with his friends. They beat him and leave him half dead. To recover from his physical and cognitive injuries, he travels to his ancestral home to help care for his dying Uncle Hugo. Then the human skull of an old childhood friend turns up in the elm in the garden.

What She Knew: A Novel by Gilly Macmillan describes the pain and guilt of a mother whose child goes missing. Divorced Mom Rachel lets her young son run ahead of her with his dog in the park but he disappears by the time she catches up to him. The media berates her for negligence as police eliminate suspects and suspense mounts with no sign of Ben.

Straying: A Novel by Molly McCloskey is the story of a young American woman who moves to the West Coast of Ireland in the 1980s where she marries and then has a summer fling with a writer. The marriage disintegrates and she spends years working for NGOs in Sri Lanka, Kosovo, Kenya, and Somalia before returning to Dublin in an attempt to face why her marriage failed.

The follow-up to *The Promise of Breeze Hill* by Pam Hillman of the *Natchez Trace* historical romance series is *The Road to Magnolia Glen*. In 1792 Mississippi, three sisters leave Ireland for Natchez where Kiera is to marry a man chosen for her by her brother-in-law. On the ship, she meets Quinn O'Shea. Of course, they dislike each other immediately. Quinn discovers that the brother-in-law's intentions are less than honorable. He feels compelled to come to their rescue and falls in love with Kiera.




