#### **BOOKBUZZ**

There is a variety of nonfiction titles available this month to check out.

*JFK: Coming of Age in the American Century, 1917-1956* by Pulitzer Prize winner and Harvard professor Fredrik Logevall is the result of the author's long journey to discover the real John F. Kennedy. In this first of two volumes, Lovegall covers the rise of the Kennedy clan from working class Irish immigrants to JFK's decision to run for the presidency at the age of 39.

Americana (And the Art of Getting Over It) by Luke Healy is a part graphic novel/part text account of the author's experience hiking the Pacific Coast Trail, a trip that took 5 months for the 2600-mile trek.

An Irish cartoonist who loves the United States, he lived through extreme weather and injuries. Healy had never backpacked or hiked before planning this journey.

JP McMahon is a chef in Galway with his own restaurant and cooking school. *The Irish Cookbook* that he has written is a wide range collection of 480 home-cooking recipes and a history of food in Ireland. He celebrates traditional dishes from all over his native land.


