## Padraic Pearse Center

### BOOK BUZZ

Here are a few selections for winter reading. The three new fiction choices center on strong women and their family relationships.

*The Queen of Dirt Island* by Donal Ryan is a tale of three generations of women in Tipperary. Saoirse is the daughter of a single mother whose husband died a few days after their daughter's birth. Her paternal grandmother lives nearby. The three of them share a strong bond of love. Saoirse's life is complicated by the connections her uncles have to the IRA, but her unexpected pregnancy at the age of 16 tests the bonds of family of these three women.

*The Making of Her* by Bernadette Jiwa starts with the marriage of Joan Quinn to Martin Egan in 1965 Dublin. On the surface, their life seems perfect. They have a daughter named Carmel. But they have a long-kept secret. Before their marriage when they were still teenagers, they gave a daughter up for adoption. In 1996, Joan and Martin are surprised by a visit from her who now needs their help in a matter of life and death. The family's secret begins to unravel.

Carlene O'Connor offers the first in her new County Kerry cozy mystery series, *No Strangers Here*. The first case for DI Cormac O'Brien is the murder of a wealthy racehorse owner, Johnny O'Reilly, in the small, picturesque town of Dingle. His body is found staged on the beach with black stones spelling out the words Last Dance, the name of a promising colt killed 27 years earlier. He was poisoned with a toxic veterinary medication. Clues point to a local veterinarian, Dr. Wilde. His daughter, also a vet, rushes to the village to help clear her father's name.

To switch to different genre, *A Guest at the Feast* is a new collection of essays by bestselling fiction author, Colm Toibin (*Brooklyn*). The three topics covered are personal essays, the power of the Catholic Church and the papacy, and literary essays. He discusses his own experience with treatment for his case of testicular cancer, his attendance at Catholic boarding school in the 1960s where he was taught by priests who were later convicted of sexual abuse, and discussions of the works of classic authors.
