

#### The Irish Echo award's Seanna Conway

Neil Conway is proud to report that on February 26 his daughter, Seanna Conway, who is an attorney, special prosecutor in Lake County, teacher and head coach of Gilmour Academy's Girls Prep Hockey Team, was honored as a member of The Irish Echo's 40 Under 40 Awards. The award was presented by the Irish Ambassador to the United States, Daniel Mulhall. Seanna lived in Ireland for five years where she was a member of the Irish National Women's Hockey Team, earning two MVP awards in World Championships held in Bulgaria and Turkey. Seanna earned an MA from the National University of Ireland Galway; and a law degree from Griffith College in Dublin, Ireland. She was also the first female to play in the Irish "A" division of men's ice hockey, as well as organizing the first ever All Women Ice Hockey Tournament held at the Dundalk Ice Dome in Ireland as a fundraiser for the Irish Cancer Society. There the host team, the Dundalk Lady Bulls, defeated Scotland 3-1 in the final, as well as the Alaska Selects and the Belfast Vixens en route. Since returning home she earned an LLM from Brooklyn Law School and was a prosecutor for three years before accepting the head coaching position at Gilmour. She is admitted to practice law in Ohio and New York. Seanna and her brother, Neil, are former dancers with Murphy Irish Arts.

#### **BOOKBUZZ**

Here is a selection of books to keep you company this month. Bestselling Irish-American author Nora Roberts can do no wrong. She is a master storyteller. One of her most recent books is *Hideaway*, a story of a child star born to Hollywood royalty. When she was nine, Caitlyn Sullivan was abducted and held captive. After her return, her family kept her secluded and safe in western Ireland to give her time to heal and gather her courage for a return to Hollywood.

*Irish Parade Murder*, a cozy mystery is a new offering by Leslie Meier just in time for Saint Patrick's Day. Lucy Stone returns from her father's funeral in Florida to find a new young reporter, Rob Callahan, trying to steal her job at the local newspaper. The only assignment she can grab from him is coverage of the Saint Patrick's Day parade, but Rob is accused of murdering a corrections officer. It's up to Lucy to clear his name, but that may change the lives of other people in town in the process.

After the Roof Caved In: An Immigrant's Journey from Ireland to America is the true story of the CEO of Northwest Health, Michael J. Dowling. In his memoir, Dowling tells of his rags-to-riches life from growing up in poverty in the rural village of Knockaderry, Ireland, where they had no running water or a stable roof. He rose to become the employer of 68,000 people in 700 facilities and gives his thanks to a good education and hard work.

For the teens this month, there is *Barry Squires: Full Tilt* by Heather Smith of Newfoundland. In 1995, teenager Finbar (Barry) Squires wants to join a popular Irish dance troupe at the peak of popularity of *Riverdance*, but his parents don't take him seriously. He is a misfit who is dealing with parents who don't understand him. And what teen doesn't deal with that issue? The author includes a cast of quirky characters in town, like his adorable little brother Gord, his grandmother, the residents of the One Step Closer to God nursing home, and friend Saibal who constantly gets him into trouble.




