BOOK BUZZ

Some suggested readings for the New Year that you may enjoy:

Callous by mystery writer Ken Bruen tells the story of a heroin-addicted woman from Brooklyn who inherits a cottage from her aunt in Claddagh, Galway. Kate Mitchell thinks a life at the seaside might just be the ticket to help her kick her habit, so she travels to Ireland with her two brothers, one a priest and former cop and the other an ex-Marine with PTSD. They learn that Aunt Mary was murdered by a drug lord who wants to use the cottage as a meth lab. Just another day in the neighborhood...

The Dublin Driver Mysteries series introduces us to Catie Murphy's main character, Megan Malone. Megan is an American Army veteran who moved to Ireland and now works as a driver for the Leprechaun Limousine Service. Book 1 is **Dead in Dublin** about restaurant critic Elizabeth Darr who dies at the foot of the statue of Molly Malone after eating seafood at a restaurant owned by a friend of Megan's. Book 2 is **Death on the Green** about finding the body of golfer Lou MacDonald in a water hazard on a golf course during a tournament. Book 3 is **Death of an Irish Mummy** about a rich Texan, Cherise Williams, who wants a DNA sample from a mummified earl in St. Michan's Church to prove she is a descendant. She is murdered and the chief suspect is Megan's boss and friend at the limo service.

As You Were by Elaine Feeney takes us to a hospital where 39-year-old Sinead Haynes has received a terminal cancer diagnosis. She bonds with two other patients in her ward. Margaret Rose is recovering from a stroke and confides that her husband cheats on her and that her teenage daughter is pregnant. Jane, who has dementia, is a retired teacher with a husband and nine children who never visit her and secretly misses the love of her life, a woman named Ann. Feeney's stories are representative of the stories of modern Irish women and their struggles.
