

BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Let's look back at some classic Irish books to tackle this summer.

Dracula (1897) by Bram Stoker has been adapted for films more than 30 times. It is called an epistolary novel because it is written as a series of letters, diary entries, and newspaper articles. Stoker researched Transylvanian folklore as background for the novel about a vampire, Count Dracula, who moves to Victorian England and is chased by vampire killer Count Van Helsing. Stoker was born in Dublin.

James Joyce was also born in Dublin and is considered one of the most influential authors of the 20th century. His major works include: *Dubliners* (1914), a collection of 15 short stories about the Irish middle class; *A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man* (1916), a coming of age story about Stephen Dedalus as he grows as an artist. It is thought to be a biography of James Joyce himself; *Ulysses* (1922), a story told through the thoughts of three main characters and based on episodes in Homer's tale of Odysseus on his way home after the Trojan War; and *Finnegan's Wake* (1939), a novel which took 17 years to write. It abandons all narrative conventions and explores the boundaries between sleep, dreams, and waking life.

Oscar Wilde was a poet and playwright. A Picture of Dorian Gray (1890) was his only novel. The main character is a handsome young man who falls in love with an actress, Sibyl Vane, but he discards her when her acting career fades. She is so distraught that she commits suicide. As Dorian Gray becomes more vane and callous towards others he remains as young and beautiful as ever, but a portrait of him in his attic continues to age and appear meaner as time goes on.

Classics written by Irish authors have been groundbreaking literary masterpieces offered as gifts to the world, but they are also challenging reads.


