BOOK BUZZ

Irish American Club East Side's own member, Dan Hanson, has written a short mystery titled *Murder in the Cultural Gardens*. The gardens are a beautiful gem in Cleveland. They stretch along both sides of Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, and spotlight over 30 of the many nationalities and ethnicities that make up Northeast Ohio, including an Irish Garden. In this story, three friends are making a promotional film about the gardens for a university professor. All goes well until the bodies start dropping during their filming and the police eye them as suspects. They put themselves in danger to help the police solve the murders.

Old God's Time by Sebastian Barry tells the story of retired Irish police officer, Tom Kettle. Now a widower who lost not only his wife but, also, his two children, he is trying to enjoy his retirement. Then a couple of his former colleagues arrive on his doorstep to ask for his help in solving a cold case of his that involved the death of a priest who had been accused of sexual abuse. Memories from his own childhood come roaring back when he saw boys sexually abused. Will Tom be able to help solve this case, or will his past interfere?

Murder in an Irish Castle: An Absolutely Gripping Historical Cozy Mystery by Verity Bright takes place in December 1924. Lady Eleanor Swift has been invited to the ancestral home of her late uncle. When she and her butler, Clifford, arrive at the gate, they discover the body of a man who had been at her uncle's funeral. The local constable is suspicious of the timing of their arrival and expresses concern that they may be involved. Why did the body have a key in his boot and what did it fit? Who set fire to the castle and were they trying to kill Lady Eleanor? This is the 12th book of Bright's *Lady Eleanor Swift* series.

The Great Irish History Book by author Myles Dungan and illustrator Alan Dunne is an illustrated edition for children and adults that transports us from the ancient Celts to the famine ships of the 1840s and the 1916 Rising to the present. It is an introduction to the history of Ireland and the culture of her people.
