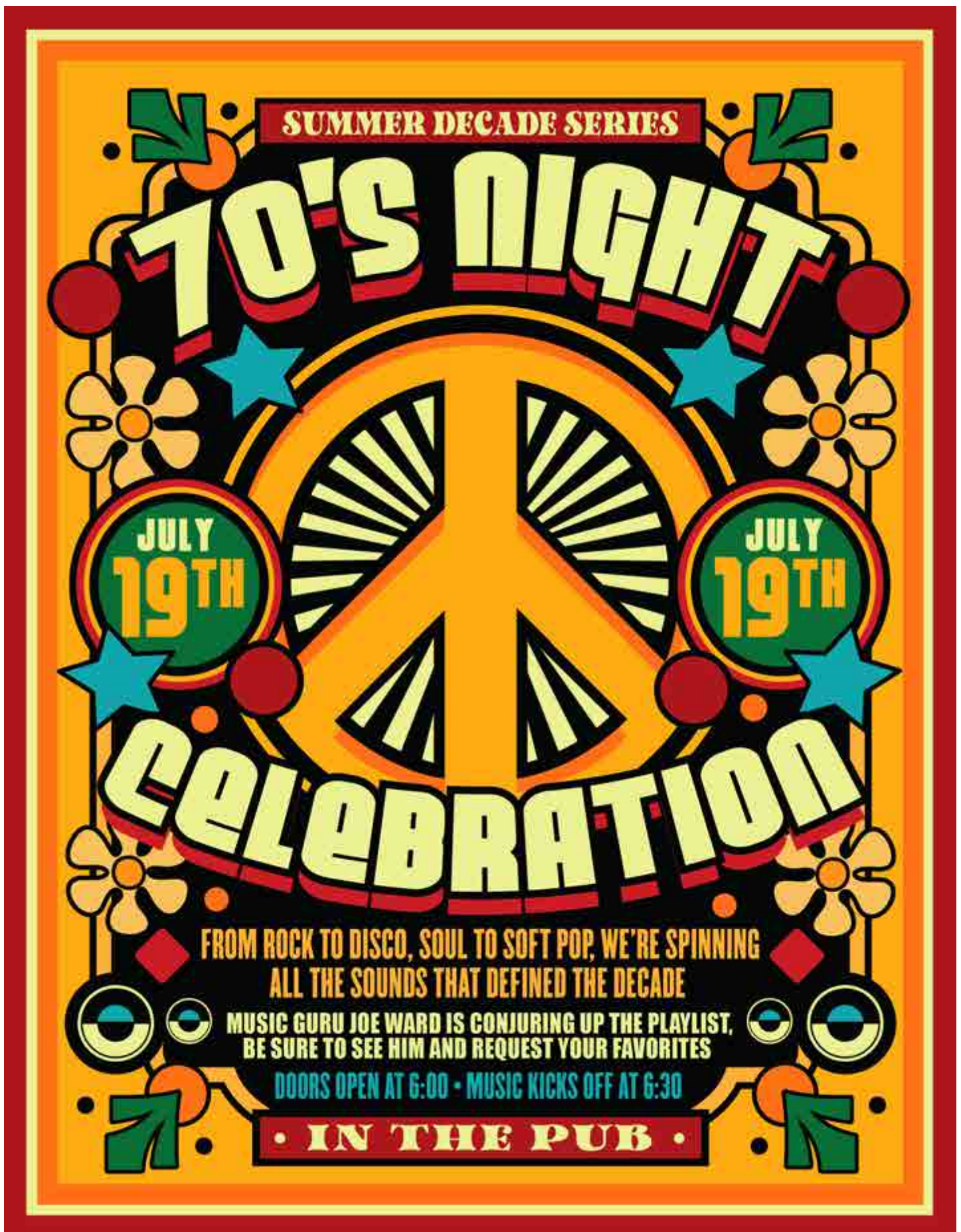

Book Buzz

Bonnie Easton

By 1848, famine had taken over all of Ireland just as England was trying to populate their colony of Australia. ***Famine Orphans*** by Patricia Falvey (***The Yellow House***) tells the story of 4,000 girls from workhouses who were put on ships to work as domestic servants in Australia and to marry and civilize the men who had been transported there as convicts. These women had a pioneering spirit to face an unknown future in a place where anti-Irish sentiment was beginning to grow. Kate Gilvarry is a girl who made that voyage. Upon landing, she finds work as a domestic for a demanding woman before marrying a sheep farmer in the Outback. There, Kate faces wild animals, heat, and loneliness while her husband leaves her alone for weeks at a time.

Evie Woods (***The Lost Bookshop***) offers two new magical books: ***The Story Collector*** (2024) and ***The Mysterious Bakery on a Rue de Paris*** (2025). ***The Story Collector*** spans two different eras. In 1911, Anna, a young farm girl, helps an American academic translate fairy tales from Irish to English for a research project, but she finds herself in the center of a mystery that threatens her way of life. One hundred years later, Sarah Harper flies to Ireland. She finds Anna's diary and attempts to unearth its dark secrets. More magic awaits readers in ***The Mysterious Bakery on Rue de Paris*** where the pastries are rumored to inspire magic, like a croissant can bring luck, or it might unlock a precious memory. Edie Lane flies from Dublin to Paris to work as the assistant manager in the bakery, but she finds it is not in Paris, but north of the city in the tiny town of Compiègne. No, it isn't where she intended to be, but she soon realizes it is where she needs to be.

Hang on St. Christopher is #8 in Adrian McKinty's Edgar Award-winning ***Sean Duffy*** series of thrillers. The year is 1992 during The Troubles in Northern Ireland. Duffy has moved his family to Scotland for their safety. He must spend six days a month in Belfast to keep his pension, but he is searching to find out who killed an IRA assassin nicknamed "the painter." While trying to solve one of his most dangerous cases, Duffy must also untangle the operations of the CIA, MI5, and Special Branch who also have their fingers in the pie.

Murder at Gull's Nest by Jess Kidd (***Himself***) is the first in the author's new cozy mystery series that takes place in a small seaside town in 1954. Nora Breen, formerly Sister Agnes, receives a release from her vows when her pen pal, Frieda, disappears. She hides her identity at the resort

as she investigates her friend's disappearance. Believing herself to be an amateur detective, Nora practices her skills until a series of murders rattles all the guests at the resort. Now, she needs to use those sleuthing skills to solve real murders.

Local author, Tom Kaschalk, founder of My Cleveland History, offers his first book, ***Cleveland's Neighborhood Taverns: A Pub Crawl Through History***, to describe Cleveland's ethnic communities. He shows readers the history of the city through the lens of its various taverns, bars, and gathering places that were often owned by several generations of the same family. Just as you will find stories when you delve into your own family tree, he uncovers stories of the hardworking immigrants who settled here.

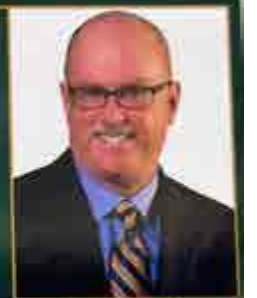
