

BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

The Friday Afternoon Club: A Family Memoir by Griffin Dunne is an autobiography that is being talked about everywhere lately. The author was raised in an Irish American Catholic family. He is the son of investigative reporter and producer Dominique Dunne and activist Ellen Griffin Dunne. His sister, Dominique, who starred in the movie Poltergeist, was strangled by her boyfriend and left for dead when she was just 22 years old. She died five days later after being removed from life support. Her mother founded Justice for Homicide Victims, a victims' rights organization. The author is an actor, director, and producer in TV and films and was once married to actress Carey Lowell. His story may be an interesting read.

The Coast Road: A Novel by Alan Murrin takes place in a small town in Ireland in the mid 1990s. In his debut novel, Murrin focuses on three unhappy wives before divorce was an option in their country. Izzy wants her husband James to buy back the lease to the florist shop he relinquished. She finds a sympathetic ear in the parish priest, Brian Dempsey, but James discovers the affair. He is active in politics and holds some influence. Dolores Mullen is expecting her fourth child with abusive husband Shaun. Colette, a poet, left her husband and sons for a while and has now returned to repair the damage with her children. Donal bans her from seeing them. In the meantime, there are complications. Donal is sleeping with Colette. All are subject to community gossip. It sounds like a soap opera.

The Detective Up Late by Adrian McKinty is the seventh installment in the author's Sean Duffy series that are set in Northern Ireland during the 1980s. McKinty sets this installment in 1990 when Duffy is finally sober, married, and a father. He is also planning on retiring, but a tinker girl goes missing. The Troubles

had brought 1,200 related murders. Duffy is a Catholic boy serving in the Royal Ulster Constabulary as a detective, a rarity at the time. There is none of our modern technology to help—no cell phones, no laptops, and no Google. The author is teasing that this is the last of the series.

Secrets in the Little Irish Village: A Completely Addictive Small Town Romance is the fourth installment in author Michelle Vernel's The Little Irish Village series. The plot sounds a bit like a Romeo and Juliet rip-off. Grace Kelly (no, not that Grace Kelly) takes in a roommate in her London flat to help with the rent, but Christopher Dorrance is the son of her family's archrival. The couple become romantically involved. When a friend and her son are left homeless, they return to Ireland to help them without disclosing to their families anything about their relationship. They hope the feud has been resolved by this time. Unfortunately, it is still going strong. Do they break up, or do they try to solve the issues between their families? The three preceding titles are Christmas in the Little Irish Village, New Beginnings in the Little Irish Village.

Oldies but goodies for this month: *Bee Sting* by Paul Murray, *The Good People* by Hannah Kent, *Philomena: The True Story of a Mother and the Son She Had to Give Away* by Martin Sixsmith, the *Nora Gavin* series by Erin Hart, and *Queen of Dirt* by Donal Ryan.


