BOOK BUZZ

Today, the largest matchmaking event is held in Lisdoonvarra, Ireland, during September and October where 400,000 people are usually in attendance. Matchmakers in Ireland were usually male because there was money involved in deciding on a dowry, etc. In the historical romance, *The Irish Matchmaker: A Novel* by Jennifer Diebel, Jimmy Daly and his partner-daughter, Catriona, join forces to help two new clients. Andrew is the handsome son of Lord Osbourne while cattle farmer, Donal Bunratty, is a widower with an eight-year-old daughter who needs a mum. Catriona is seeking a match for herself, first a leaning toward Andrew, but she is then drawn to the shy Donal. Complications arise when Donal and Andrew negotiate a risky business deal together.

The Altar Girls is the 13 entry in Patricia Gibney's DI Lottie Parker mystery series. Warning: This story involves the murder of little girls. A twisted killer has left the bodies of two little girls dressed in white robes and fingers interlaced with a rosary as if in prayer and then left frozen in the snow. Lottie suspects their parents are lying and she doesn't know who to trust. Then a choirboy is reported missing. Can she prevent another murder before it's too late?

Knock Knock Open Wide is a horror fiction novel by Neil Sharpson. On a stormy night in 1979, Etain Larkin finds a faceless corpse on the road. A few days later, she is found half-dead near a burned-out farmhouse, and she remembers nothing about what led to her injuries. Ten years later, one of her eight-year-old twin daughters, Niamh, disappears and her husband dies of an apparent suicide. Etain descends into alcoholism and is trying to raise her other twin, Ashling, Fast forward to 2023 with Ashling in college and falling in love with her girlfriend. She wants to know what happened to her family. Seemingly, it may involve a child on an old children's TV show and a goat puppet hidden in a box who would come out only if a child misbehaves. What will happen if he comes out?

Genealogist Chris Paton offers a new reference book, *Tracing Your Belfast Ancestors: A Guide for Family Historians*. He gives a short history of this Northern Irish city before veering into finding resources, both in print in the city and online.


