In Memoriam: Frank Vitek and Michael McBride

The IACES Pipe Band lost two of its founding members in the last several months; that is, tenor drummer Frank Vitek at age 90, and lead drummer/snare drummer and composer Michael McBride at age 71.

The band was originally founded in 1948 as the Caledonian Pipe Band, and was later renamed the North Coast Pipe Band by Pipe Major Douglas Ross, which became the official pipe band of the Irish American Club around 1988 under the leadership of then President Mickey Coyne.

Frank Vitek was known for his amazing ability to incorporate a band pulse as a "swinging tenor" with his trademark, a hand painted drum made at the band's inception. Frank was honored at his funeral with solo piping performances by artist/piper Lynne Lofton and Pipe Major Bruce Greig of the IACES Pipe Band joining the Vitek family, with written tributes by Drum Major/piper Dan Rabkewych and piper/writer Peter Strozniak. Frank was the winner of solo recognition including a first-place medal at the Can-Am Games held in Sarnia, Ontario.

Michael was the author of the pipe band drum scores, which lead the band to unprecedented success. Both Frank

and Michael were members when the band won Best Overseas Band and first U.S. pipe band to place at the World Pipe Band Championships in Glasgow, Scotland. If that wasn't enough, they were also ranked first in the United States by defeating all four grade 1 U.S. bands at the Delco Highland Games near Philadelphia. Further, they were first place in the Cleveland St. Patrick's Day Parade; and first place victories in contests at the Ohio Scottish Games, Chevrolet Celtic Classic in Bethlehem (PA), Virginia Scottish Games, Vail Celtic Festival (CO), Santa Rosa Highland Games (CA), Edinboro Highland Games (PA), Ligonier Highland Games (PA) where they won the challenge to grade 1 over the former North American Champions the Clan MacFarlane Pipe Band (St. Catharines, Ontario), the Canadian Championship (Cambridge, Ontario), and the U.S. Open Pipe Band Championship (Alma, MI).

Prior to pipe band drumming, Michael was the drummer for the notorious Cleveland rock and roll band the Raspberries, who are honored in the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland.

BOOKBUZZ

It is finally time to say goodbye to 2020. May 2021 bring you all good health and good fortune.

Here are lots of interesting reads to start the new year.

The Shortest Day by Colm Toibin (author of the popular **Brooklyn**) offers an exclusive short story in Amazon Kindle format. Professor O'Kelley, an archeologist, is hunting for the secret of the ancient burial site at Newgrange in County Meath. He is not discouraged by the ghost stories told by local townsfolk.

Chosen as the winner of the Women's Prize for Fiction and a New York Times best book of the year, *Hamnet* by Northern Irish writer Maggie O'Farrell is a novel about the life of a family with 11 year-old twins in Stratford, England, in 1596. Little Judith falls ill with bubonic plague. Their mother, Agnes, is gifted in the use of healing herbs, but she sees the future in which one of her twins dies. Judith survives her illness, but Agnes' son, Hamnet, succumbs to the disease, while her husband is away in London seeking fame and fortune as a playwright. O'Farrell is telling the story of the lives of William Shakespeare and Anne Hathaway.

In *Big Girl, Small Town: A Novel* by Michelle Gallen, Majella O'Neill is a 20 something young woman with autism who works in a takeout restaurant in a Northern Irish town. She appears to be living a boring, predictable life, but it is more complex than that. Told with dark humor, Majella struggles to find her place in the town while living with the memory of her grandmother's murder, her mother's alcoholism, and her father's disappearance.

Little Cruelties by Liz Nugent is a dark psychological thriller about the sibling rivalry of brothers William, Brian, and Luke. The book opens with a funeral of one of the brothers, but which one isn't revealed until the plot twist at the end.

The art world is the setting of Danielle McLaughlin's debut novel, *The Art of Falling: A Novel*. Nessa McMormack is a curator for an art gallery preparing an exhibition of the late sculptor Robert Locke's work, but the artist's wife and mistress are vying for control of the pieces. In the meantime, Nessa is trying to heal her own marriage after her husband's infidelity and to keep a secret from her past.

For those who enjoy historical novels about the Great Famine and the 1916 Rising, Irish author Marita Conlon-McKenna has written *The Hungry Road: The Gripping and Heartbreaking Novel of the Irish Famine* and *Rebel Sisters: The Epic and Heartbreaking Story of Three Extraordinary Women Fighting for Ireland's Freedom*,

both available in digital and paperback formats. *The Hungry Road* tells the stories of a seamstress, a doctor, and a priest striving to survive the suffering of the Great Famine in 1845. *Rebel Sisters* is a fictional account of the three beautiful and intelligent Gifford sisters during the First World War and The Rising. Grace, an artist, married Joseph Mary Plunkett in Kilmainham Gaol the night before his execution by the British for his leadership in the Rising. Muriel was the wife of rebel Thomas MacDonagh, also executed for The Rising. Nellie joined Countess Constance Markieivicz at St. Stephen's Green and helped with the distribution of provisions, an action which landed her in Kilmainham Gaol at the same time as her two brothers-in-law.
