

ALL AMERICAN PIE

- 1 (10-inch) baked deep-dish pie crust
- 1 qt. fresh strawberries.
- 4 (1 oz.) sq. white baking chocolate
- 1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened
- 3/4 c. milk
- 1 small instant pudding mix
 (vanilla, white chocolate or cheesecake flavor)
- 1 1/2 c. fresh blueberries
- 1 c. Cool Whip

Prepare pie crust; cool. Meanwhile, hull half the strawberries, setting aside the better-looking half. Cut hulled strawberries into slices or chunks. Melt the white chocolate (in microwave if possible). Stir until smooth. Dip the unhulled whole strawberries half-way into melted white chocolate. Set aside on waxed paper to dry. Pour remaining white chocolate into cooled pie crust. Top with the sliced strawberries.

Beat the cream cheese, then whisk in milk and instant pudding mix until thickened. Pour over strawberries. Spread evenly, then top with blueberries. Edge crust with small dollops of Cool Whip or use pastry bag to decorate the florets. Place dipped strawberries along edge in the Cool Whip, with green tops along the outside. Refrigerate or serve immediately. Serves 10.

BOOKBUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Let's start off with a few recent biographies of Irish Americans.

Although Senator John McCain (R-AZ) is dealing with brain cancer, he still has more to say in his memoir *Restless Wave: Good Times, Just Causes, Great Fights and Other Appreciations*. He talks about losing the 2008 presidential election to Barack Obama and his views on world affairs. He discusses his bipartisan work with Senate colleagues and his wish that government could work that way again.

Pulitzer Prize winning journalist Eileen McNamara covers the life of Eunice Kennedy Shriver (1921—2009). *Eunice: The Kennedy Who Changed the World* is the story of the life of the determined woman who advocated for the rights of people with disabilities and founded the Special Olympics. Her interest in social change stemmed from her love for her older sister Rosemary, who had developmental disabilities.

MSNBC commentator Chris Matthews offers a biography, *Bobby Kennedy: A Raging Spirit*, about the New York Senator who was assassinated in 1968. He traces Bobby's evolution from advisor to his brother, President John F. Kennedy, to his own fight for the presidency. Matthews tells of his own experiences as a Viet Nam War protester and the development of his political views as a follower of Robert Kennedy.

Now for some new fiction selections.

The latest from actor turned novelist David Duchnovy (*X-Files*) is *Miss Subways: A Novel*. He bases his story on the Irish myth of Emer and Cu Chulainn. In this modern adaptation, Emer shuts her eyes to boyfriend Con's infidelities. One night in a dream, a Celtic fairy dressed as a doorman shows her on a cell phone app that Con will die in a car accident unless she stops seeing him. After the breakup, they continue to run into each other on the subway. Their attraction for each other has not diminished. What is their fate?

Beloved Irish short story writer William Trevor died in 2016 after an impressive career of writing fourteen novels and thirteen collections of short stories. This final compilation of short stories, *Lost Stories*, gives insight into the lives of ordinary people with themes of personal cruelty, romantic and marital heartbreak, death, and betrayal. He demonstrates how they find the strength to move on with their lives.
