





Some of this month's suggestions are destined to be on the bestsellers' lists.

If you are one of the legions of Dirk Pitt fans, you will be rewarded by Celtic Empire by Clive Cussler and his son Dirk, the 25th installment in the popular series. A number of sea disasters involves a biotech company and a cholera-like disease. The incurable disease stems from ancient Egypt and is spreading. The only cure seems to be an ancient one that was carried by an Egyptian princess to Ireland.

Another book creating a lot of buzz is Say Nothing: A True Story of Murder and Memory in Northern Ireland by Patrick Radden Keefe. A widowed mother of 10, Jean McConville, was snatched by an IRA gang in 1972. The author makes his case that Gerry Adams, a leader of Sinn Fein, ordered her murder because she was an informant to the British.

When All Is Said: A Novel is the debut offering of Irish author Anne Griffin. Eighty-four-year-old Maurice Hannigan orders five drinks at the local hotel bar in County Meath. He lines them up to toast each of five family members who influenced his life: his older brother, his unstable sister-in-law, his stillborn daughter, his son in America, and the wife he misses terribly. Intertwined with his toasts is the story of his life. One of the characters is a commemorative coin with the face of King Edward VIII that he stole from an employer who bullied him.

One last selection is an Irish history book written for teens, The Partition of Ireland by Cathleen Small, to answer the question of how Ireland became divided. It includes photographs, maps, and sidebars to trace the history of the conflict. It may also be a great read for adults who need a quick and easy read to understand the times.

Sue & Bruce McGill are also expecting their first grandchild.






