

Bookbuzz Bonnie Easton

Cozy mysteries are favorites of readers everywhere. Their authors use the power of the story and its characters along with humor to move the plot along. The setting for this genre is usually small towns with quirky residents and amateur sleuths who try to solve a murder. They are sort of like a Hallmark movie. The following authors place their series in small villages in Ireland.

The *County Cork Mystery Series* by Sheila Connolly stars Maura Donovan. She travels to Ireland to visit the town where her grandmother was born and decides to stay. She finds a job working in the local pub. (*Buried in a Bog*, *Scandal in Skibbereen*, *An Early Wake*, *A Turn for the Bad*, *Cruel Winter*, *Many a Twist*, *The Lost Traveller*)

Carlene O'Connor writes the *Murder in an Irish Village Mystery Series* about Siobhan O'Sullivan who opens Naomi's Bistro with her five siblings in Kilbane, County Cork after their parents are killed in a car crash. Townsfolk stop in for a cup of tea and local gossip. Bodies keep showing up in strange places. (*Murder in an Irish Village*, *Murder in an Irish Wedding*, *Murder in an Irish Churchyard*, *Murder in an Irish Pub*)

Author Zara Keane grew up in Dublin and spent her childhood summers in the small town of Ballybeg. Her *Movie Club Mysteries Series* are more contemporary in style than the others. Her crime solver is Maggie Doyle, a one-time San Francisco cop who moves to Ireland to escape her cheating ex-husband and start a new life. She begins working as a private investigator. (*Dial P for Poison*, *The Postman Always Dies Twice*, *How to Murder a Millionaire*, *The 39 Cupcakes*, *Rebel without a Claus*)

David Ahern is a research psychologist who abandoned his training to write the *Madam Tulip Mysteries*. His main character is actress Derry O'Donnell who moonlights as a fortune teller to celebrities, but her Madam Tulip alter ego often finds herself involved in intrigue and murder. (*Madam Tulip, Madam Tulip and the Knave of Hearts*, *Madam Tulip and the Bones of Chance*)


