BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

A new travel guide to Ireland, *Always Ireland: An Insider's Tour of the Emerald Isle* by Jack Kavanagh, was released this year by *National Geographic* and covers most of its counties from Dublin's historic sites to Co. Clare's Cliffs of Moher. Kavanagh was born in Co. Wicklow and gives us his own view of his beautiful country. He includes 300 *National Geographic* photos and suggested itineraries with practical travel tips for your vacation.

Dublin-born author John Connolly has been writing his Charlie Parker thrillers since 1999 and just released the 20th book in his series. His protagonist is a private detective in Portland, Maine. This addition is two novellas in one volume, *Sisters Strange* and *Furies* under the title *Furies: A Thriller*. The cases in the two stories are related. He is investigating ex-con Raum Burke for threatening his two ex-lovers. The cases become intertwined with the COVID pandemic and other current events.

Author Don Winslow follows up his bestseller *City on Fire: A Novel* with *City of Dreams: A Novel*. Danny Ryan is a young widower who is a member of the Irish crime syndicate. He and his little boy escape New England and his troubles with the mob for sunny Los Angeles to work in the film industry. The author compares the turf war between the Italians and the Irish to Homer's *Iliad*. Ryan is running from the FBI, the cops, and the Mafia. Then he falls in love with a film star. The conclusion to the trilogy is *City in Ruins*, scheduled to be released in March 2024.

John Banville offers another installment in his Dr. Quirke series about a pathologist in Dublin in the 1950s. Banville has abandoned the pen name Benjamin Black that he used to write his crime series. In *The Lock-Up*, a young scholar, Rosa Jacobs, is found dead. Her German friends had arrived in Ireland under mysterious circumstances after World War II. As Quirke and his associate come closer to a solution, everyone involved in the case is in danger, including Quirke's daughter. Rosa died of carbon monoxide poisoning. Is it a suicide or is it a murder?

Song of the Sea was an Oscar-nominated animated film in 2014 by Universal Studios. Samuel Sattin has based a children's graphic novel on the movie about 10-year-old Ben and his six-year-old sister Saoirse, who doesn't speak. Their mother disappeared one night after her daughter was born, and their grandmother takes them to live in the city

with her. They run away back to their home on the coast and discover that little Saoirse, like her mother, is a selkie. She will wither away and die unless she can return to the coat of a seal in the ocean.!
