BOOK BUZZ

Bonnie Easton

Here are some new books to start off your fall season.

The Colony: A Novel by Audrey Magee is a multilayered story set in 1979 on a small island off the coast of Ireland. A British painter, known as Mr. Lloyd, and a French linguist, Jean-Pierre Masson, rent houses next door to each other and find themselves at odds. Lloyd discovers a teenager there who is a talented artist and young James just might be better than he was at his age. James' mother is modeling for Lloyd and sleeping with Masson. In the background of their story is the tension playing out between Loyalists and the Irish Republican Army in the era of the Troubles.

Listening Still: A Novel by Anne Griffin (*When All Is Said*) tells the story of Jeanie Masterson who has the ability to speak to the recently dead. She is not sure whether she has been given a gift or a curse. Seventeen years earlier, she gave up the chance to move to London with a boy she loved. Instead, she stayed to help her parents in their undertaker business in the small Irish town of Kilcross. This ability that she inherited from her father comes in handy in their business. Now, her marriage is floundering, her parents want to retire and give her control of their business, and the old boyfriend has returned. To find some distance from her conundrum, she visits a friend in Oslo. What path will she take to find happiness?

Tell Everyone on This Train I Love Them: Essays by Irish comedienne Maeve Higgins (*Maeve in America: Essays by a Girl from Somewhere Else*) offers her perspective on the contemporary issues America is facing. As an immigrant, she tries to understand American viewpoints on the pandemic, racism, and climate change by interviewing Border Security Agents, a chocolatier who laces candy with cannabis, and others. She is not mocking us but trying to relate her experiences to events in her homeland.
