Dublin-born author John Connolly has released his newest Charlie Parker Thriller, *The Children of Eve*, Book 22 of his series. Charlie has been hired to find Wyatt Riggins, the boyfriend of rising artist Zetta Nadeau of Maine. The only clue is a cell phone he left behind that says “Run.” Riggins is an ex-soldier who helped abduct the four children of a Mexican cartel boss. The father wants them back—and will do anything to find them, even if it means killing anyone who gets in his way. Except they are not the cartel boss’ children—his offspring are safe and sound in Mexico. So, who are these children and why does he want to find them?

The Moonlight Runner: A Novel by bestselling author Karen Robards is historical fiction that takes place during the Irish Rebellion following World War I. Rynn Carmichael is a nurse in a convalescent hospital and overhears British soldiers along Donegal Bay gloating about a trap set to capture gunrunners. Her fiancé, Donal O’Reilly, is one of the gunrunners, and she leaves to warn him at midnight. The soldiers take her with them through the ballrooms of London and the back alleys of Dublin. The publisher promises a thrill-packed adventure of romance and danger.

Leonard and Hungry Paul: A Novel by Ronan Hession is an offbeat story about two thirty-year-old men still living at home with their parents. They like their jobs, play board games together and like to read. All sounds almost too normal, right? Leonard is lonely since the recent death of his mother. Sometimes, readers just are looking for a book with a gentle story and kind characters, especially in our current environment.


















