Book Buzz

Here are a few new books for you this month.

Westerly: A Novel by Susan Donovan Bernhard tells the story of two young sisters who are refugees from Germany. They are sent to Ireland as World War II is ending as part of a foster care program called Operation Shamrock, and Europe is recovering from the war. Fifty years later, an Irish newspaper clipping threatens to topple the life of the Sullivan family in a farmhouse in Maine. They must bring their family back together again and face the secrets that threaten to tear them apart.

Away with the Fairies by Leoma Retan is aimed at 8 to 13-year-olds and offers them tales of a journey through danger, folklore, and surprises, with meetings with leprechauns, and fairies along the way. Lots of magic here, but leprechauns aren't always happy beings and fairies are not necessarily weak and tiny beings.

Irish Mythology for Teens: Enthralling Tales and Legends from Ancient Ireland by Billy Wellman presents stories of Irish heroes, like Cu Chulainn and Fionn Cumhaill, leprechauns, banshees, and St. Brigid.

The Famine Orphans by Patricia Falvey (*The Yellow House*) tells readers about 4,000 young women from all over Ireland who board ships for Australia in 1848. They have an opportunity to find work as domestic servants. Most were orphans and all had spent time in workhouses. The unstated purpose of the project was to "domesticate" the men who had been sent there as convicts and encourage them to marry and create settlements in the new land. One of the women is Kate Gilvarry who came from a workhouse to work for a demanding Englishwoman before marrying a farmer and joining him in the lonely life of the Outback with its oppressive heat and drought.

Anne Enright (*The Gathering*, a Booker Prize Winner) is a prolific Irish writer of novels, short stories, and essays. She is considered one of Ireland's greatest living writers. Her latest publication is *Attention:*

Writing on Life, Art, and the World. These thirty essays have been collected from her thirty year-career with observations and insights on politics, society, and literary criticism from a feminine viewpoint.
