## Padraic Pearse Center

### BOOK BUZZ

Bestselling author Dennis LeHane grew up pretending to be a tough kid in the poor Irish neighborhood of Dorchester near Boston while trying to hide that he had the soul of a writer who devoured classic literature. In his newest novel, *Small Mercies*, Mary Pat Feenie's daughter, Jules, stays out late on the same night as a young black man is found dead in a housing project in 1974 Boston. The city is exploding with riots over desegregation and the Irish Mob is in a position of power. Are the two events of Jules disappearance and the dead black man related?

*Juno Loves Legs* by Karl Geary is the story of two teenagers in the 1980s who live in the housing projects of Dublin and attend a strict Catholic school. Both are outcasts: she (Juno) for being poor and he (Legs or Sean) for his sexuality. Legs is sentenced to a juvenile detention center until he turns 18 for dumping cement down a toilet in protest of an abusive priest. Juno drops out of school to live on the streets of Dublin. Their friendship survives the trauma and bleakness of their lives whole and unbroken.

*The Gaslight Mystery* series by Victoria Thompson features former Detective Sgt. Frank Malloy and his wife, Sarah Brandt. Both are Irish immigrants. The series is set in 1900s New York City. In this 26th book of the series, they try to help a young mother whose cruel and unfaithful husband, Chet Longby, has placed her in an insane asylum. A maid in the Longby household dies under suspicious circumstances. Sarah, a midwife, and Frank need to solve the case and return the young mother to her newborn.

Another long running series featuring an Irish immigrant is the Molly Murphy Mysteries, now with the publication of its 19th book. Author Rhys Bowen also sets her characters, Molly Murphy and her husband Police Captain Daniel Sullivan, in New York City in the early 1900s. In her latest book, Molly finds herself drawn into the world of politics with all its potential for lies and greed in *All That Is Hidden*. She and her husband don't keep secrets from each other, but is he

hiding something from her now? Has he entangled himself in some unsavory predicament?

Here is one more cozy mystery for you with three novellas by three different writers all in one book. The best known author here is Leslie Meier with her **Lucy Stone** series in *Irish Coffee Murder*. Lucy Stone is a part-time reporter for a small town newspaper in Maine. It is St. Patrick's Day, and four step dancing students and their stage mothers are rivals. Maybe the rivalry goes too far when one of the girls is found dead in the bathtub. There are two other novellas that involve murders, including *Death of an Irish Coffee Drinker* by Lee Hollis and *Perked Up* by Barbara Ross. Irish coffee takes on a whole new meaning in this collection.
